Some of the farms which supply the retailer are certified by this scheme or criteria. If it is a certain line of the product the name is stated, i.e. Aldi 'Specially selected' Scottish salmon is RSPCA Assured certified.

⁴ Only 1 of 19 own-brand salmon products is labelled as Scottish: The Best Scottish Smoked Salmon. Some suppliers are RSPCA Assured, but products are not labelled so it is unclear which products are certified.

⁵ All Sainsbury's Scottish salmon products are from RSPCA Assured farms. Just Cook En Croute products do not show the standard's label.

⁶ All conventional (Standard and Finest) Tesco salmon is 100% Global GAP accredited but Tesco do not require 100% Organic to be Global GAP accredited.
