- ✓ All Scottish salmon sold by the retailer adhere to this certification scheme or criteria; the retailer is a member of the relevant organisation; products are traceable to individual farm.
- Some of the farms which supply the retailer are certified by this scheme or criteria. If it is a certain line of the product the name is stated, i.e. Aldi ‘Specially selected’ Scottish salmon is RSPCA certified; some information available on product source and/or supplier, not traceable to individual farm.
- None of the Scottish salmon sold by the retailer appear to be certified by this scheme or criteria; no information is available (Suppliers & sources); the retailer is not a member of the relevant organisation.

<sup>1</sup> Only Iceland ‘Luxury’ salmon is labelled as Scottish and RSPCA: origin and certification of other products is unclear.

<sup>2</sup> Lidl ‘Deluxe’ Oak and Applewood Smoked Scottish salmon labelled RSPCA: certification of other products unclear.

<sup>3</sup> M&S Organic Scottish salmon meets criteria of Soil Association and other EU organic accreditation bodies: it is supplied by Cooke Aquaculture in Orkney.

<sup>4</sup> M&S developed their own standards for Lochmuir™ salmon reared by Scottish Sea Farms; Cooke Aquaculture supply organic certified salmon.

<sup>5</sup> Only 1 out of 19 own-brand salmon products is labelled as Scottish and with RSPCA labelling: The Best Scottish Smoked Salmon. It is unclear which other salmon products are Scottish.

<sup>6</sup> Majority of Sainsbury’s Scottish salmon products labelled with RSPCA, with exceptions i.e. Taste the Difference Timbale and Just Cook En Croute.

<sup>7</sup> Sainsbury’s Scottish salmon is labelled with the site it originates from, which include: Loch Erisort, Loch Leven, Loch Linnhe, Loch Hourn and Isle of Muck.

<sup>8</sup> All conventional (Standard and Finest) Tesco salmon is 100% Global GAP accredited but Tesco do not require 100% Organic to be Global GAP accredited.

<sup>9</sup> Waitrose is also developing a new scheme with 28 criteria that it requires its suppliers to monitor over 3 production cycles.
